Player Code of Conduct

Arbuckle Parks and Recreation District (APRD) offers a non-sanctioned program for the recreational enjoyment of its participants. APRD staff is the sole governing body of this softball program.

APRD reserves the right to expel any team/player from the league for reasons of conduct, failure to observe rules, regulations and procedures. The Player Code of Conduct is created to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all who utilize the APRD programs.

PLAYERS MUST EXHIBIT THE FOLLOWING CONDUCT:

- Be considerate and treat others with kindness, courtesy and respect.
- Respect the game, play fairly, and follow the rules and regulations.
- Show respect for authority to the game officials and APRD employees.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during and after games.
- Be courteous to opposing teams and treat all players with respect.
- Be modest when successful and gracious in defeat.
- Respect the privilege of the use of public facilities.
- Teams are not only responsible for the conduct of their players but also the conduct of their spectators.
- Never physically harm or cause harm to another participant or official.
- Treat all APRD staff, other players and spectators with respect at all times.
- Respect the park fields, sports equipment and facility amenities.
- Participate in a sportsmanlike and safe manner at all times.
- Uphold the league philosophy of healthy competition and sportsmanship.
- Be calm and patient and refrain from using abusive, obscene, threatening, harassing, insulting and suggestive language.
- Not engage in (or threaten) physical violence.
- Support the staff in keeping the facilities clean
- Not consuming or being under the influence of any alcoholic beverages or/and illegal drugs.
- Follow nonsmoking ordinance
- Be responsible for personal property.
- Adhere to all posted rules and signs.

If I cannot participate according to this Code of Conduct, then depending on the seriousness of the offense(s), any or all of the following consequences may occur:

- APRD personnel may demand that any person(s) violation the Code of Conduct either immediately modify their behavior, or voluntarily leave the site.
- Non-complaisance with the Code of Conduct may result in the removal of a person(s) from the APRD site, including possible arrest and prosecution, and/or the denial of access to all APRD programs from a prescribed period of time. (No refund of registration fee)
- Also, APRD personnel may deny access to any person(s) it determines to be in violation of the Code of Conduct or, as shown by past behavior, presents too great a risk for violating the Code of Conduct.
